Natural England's unique surveys

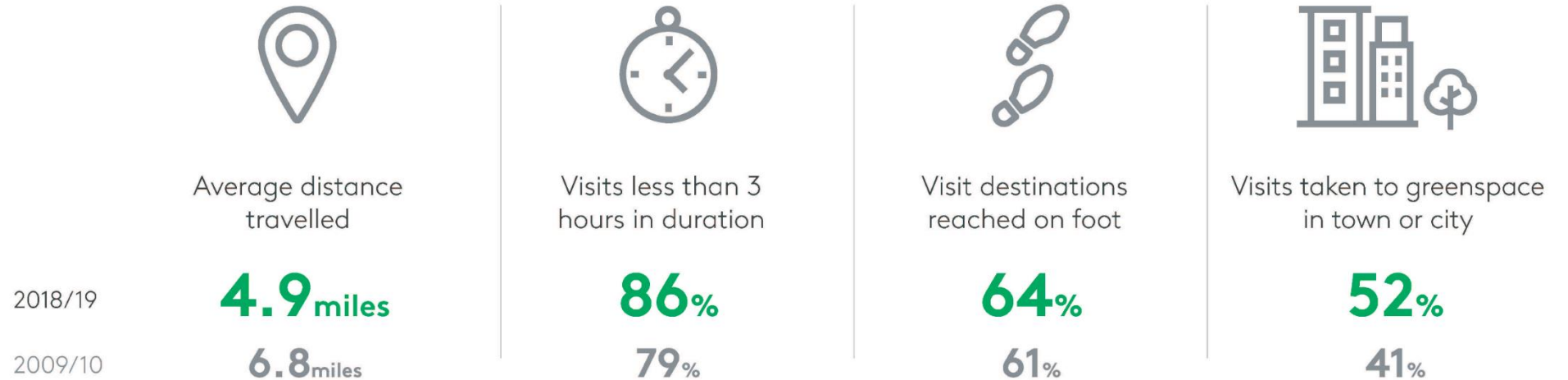
- MENE - ½ million respondents over 10 years.

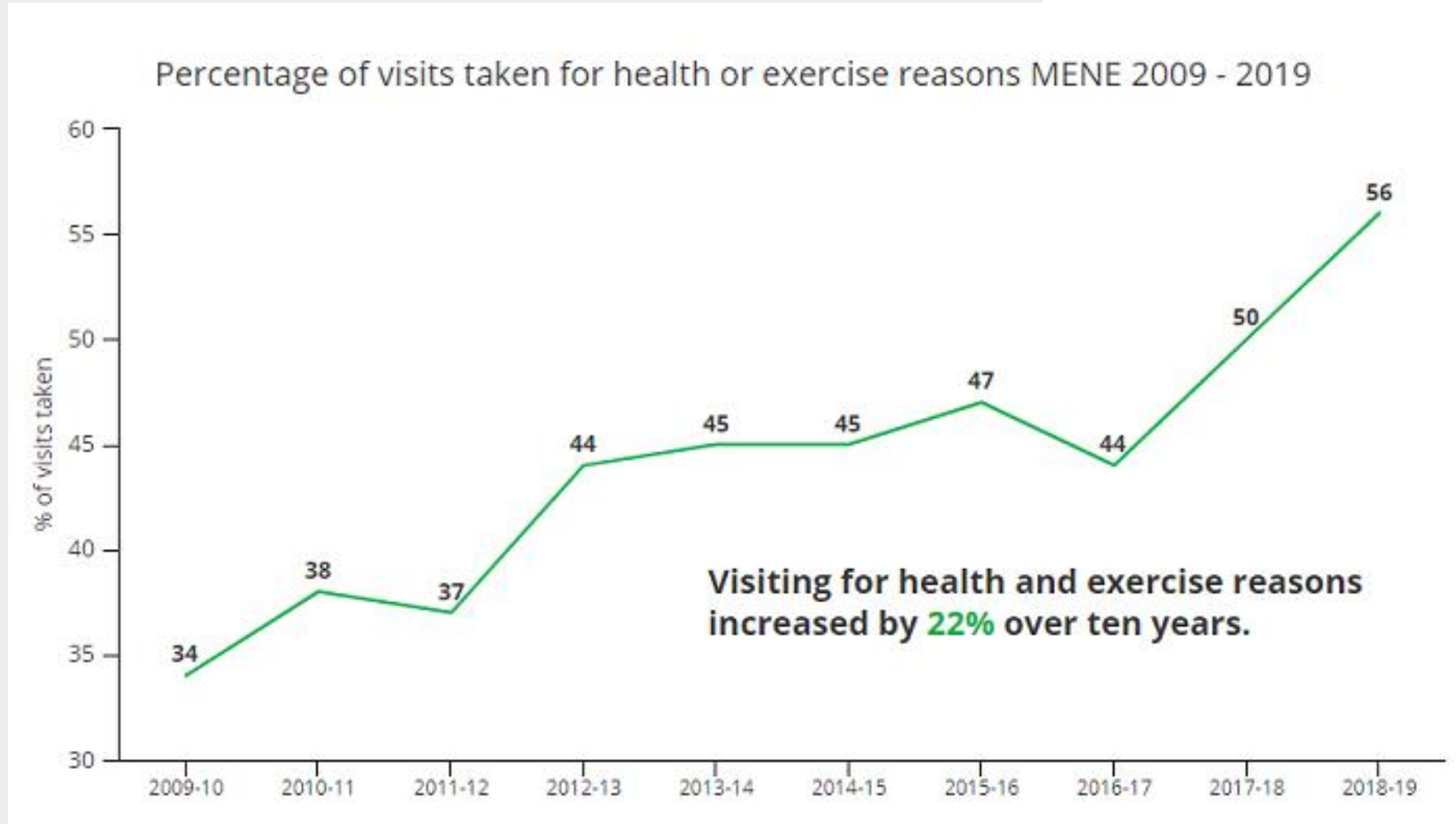
Most people's experience of the natural world is on their doorstep...
